### Rules for Anderson County Fairest of the Fair Pageants

Contestants must be completely dressed and ready backstage 10 minutes before their division start time.

#### Article I. Pageant Entry

1. Each entrant must be a resident or be enrolled in the school system of Anderson County or a municipality of which any party is in Anderson County.
2. Each Division III contestant must have reached her 8<sup>th</sup> birthday, but not her 10<sup>th</sup> birthday, on July 17, 2017.
3. Each Division II contestant must have reached her 6<sup>th</sup> birthday, but not her 8<sup>th</sup> birthday, on July 17, 2017.
4. Each Division I contestant must have reached her 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, but not her 6<sup>th</sup> birthday, on July 17, 2017.
5. An entry fee of \$30 must be submitted by the day of the pageant rehearsal before the contestant can participate. The amount of \$30 must be made payable in the form of cash and given to Shayla Sanderson or Amanda Hughes.
6. Previous winners will not be eligible for the same pageant division, but may enter the next division after reaching the appropriate age.

#### Article II. Judging

7. Contestants must wear dresses. Dresses can be short or long but exposed midriffs are not allowed.
8. Contestants may wear make up but it must be age appropriate.
9. Contestants will be judged on beauty and personality.

#### Article III. Misconduct & Liability

10. Any contestant found guilty of misconduct by the pageant committee or judges is subject to a penalty.
11. The Anderson County Fair will not be held liable for any damages that may occur to a contestant's apparel or accessories during the contest or contest activity.
12. The Anderson County Fair will not be held responsible for any bodily injury that may be incurred by a contestant during the pageant or pageant activity.
13. The Anderson County Fair will not be held responsible for lost or stolen articles during the contest or contest activity.
14. If a parent/guardian or contestant shows un-sportsman like conduct during the pageant, we reserve the right to disqualify the contestant and remove them from the facility.

Delegate or family members will not slander or libel other contestants, judges, directors, sponsors, staff, or anyone else involved with or connected to the Anderson County Fair. This will result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of any and all prizes and awards won.

If a parent/guardian, friends, or contestant shows un-sportsman like conduct during the pageant, we reserve the right to disqualify the contestant and remove them from the facility.
